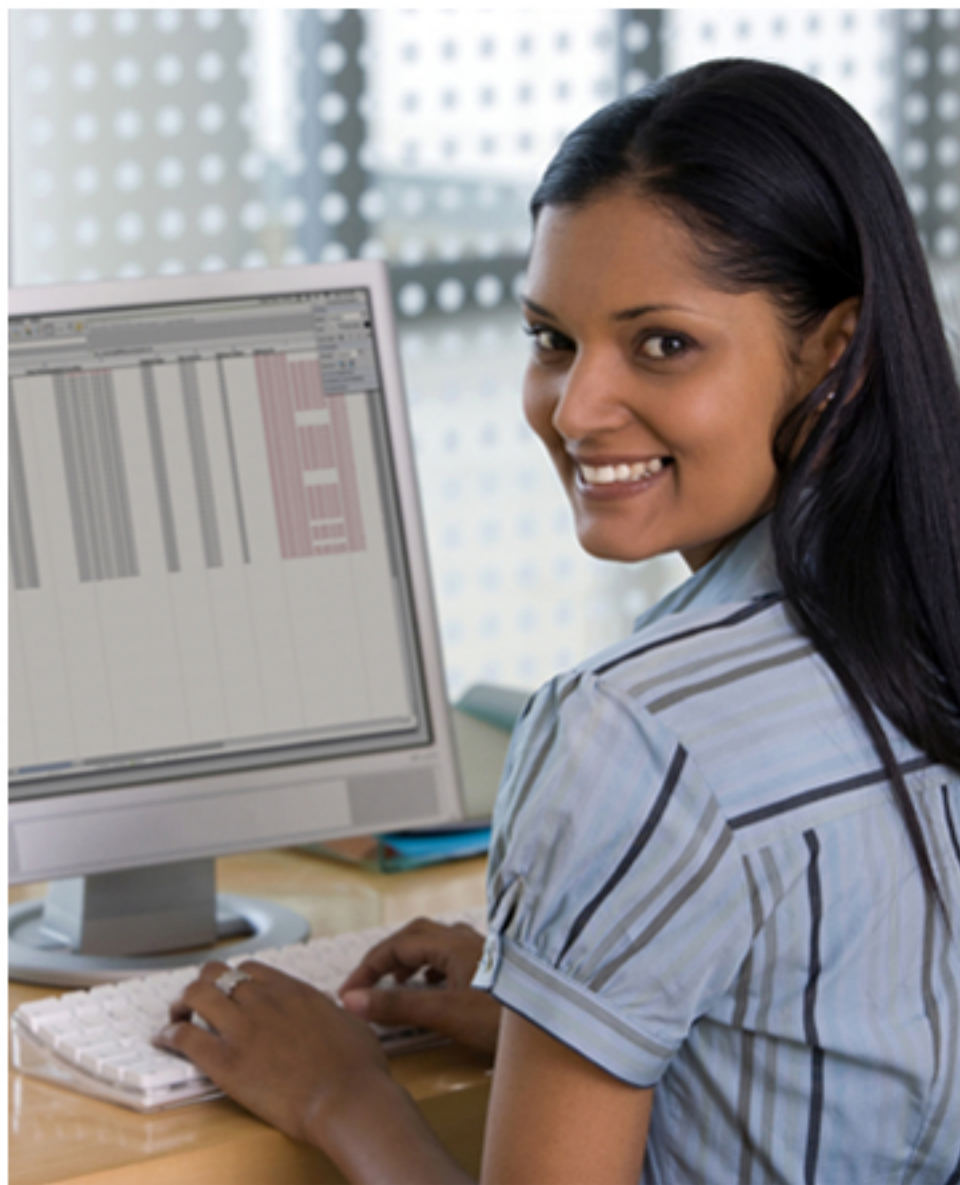


# COMPUTERIZED ACCOUNTING
